Mar Thoma College focuses keenly on the holistic development of students from every sector of the society and provides them with equal opportunities and resources in order to facilitate their career development. In continuation of our moral commitments and responsibilities towards the underprivileged students during the past 70 years the institution was able to distribute a substantial amount of Rs. 342,592/- as scholarships and endowments to the bright and needy students during the last academic year. Moreover, text books and other study materials for competitive examinations were also given to deserving students. The noon meal scheme, student aid fund etc. exemplifies our commitment to provide quality education to poor and needy students.

Student centric approaches such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies are implemented in teaching learning and evaluation methodologies. Experiential learning methods like peer teaching, knowledge partnership programmes, excursions and nature camps are conducted consistently in each department. Various Orientation/induction programmes organised at the beginning of each academic year helps the students from diverse backgrounds to adapt to the new academic environment of the

institution. Remedial coaching sessions helps academic slow learners so as to catch up with difficult topics and turn their weaknesses to strengths. Students were sent for internships and on-job training in industries and research centres so as to prepare them for the practical aspects of working in specific industries. This is achieved by research collaborations, MOUs and tie-ups with various external institutes. The college career guidance and placement cell offers training, placement drives, and collaborations with industry, that promote employment likelihoods of the students. The UGC/JRF guidance cell and college civil service academy arranges coaching and orientation for students to prepare for competitive examinations. Former students who have cleared these competitive exams were engaged as mentors for existing students. Additionally, various Skill development programmes, EDPs, hands-on training on LED bulbs and paper/cloth bag making etc. were also organised by each department. The focus is to enhance student employability by providing need based trainings and additional skill development programmes based on the employer requirements. The students were given sufficient opportunities and guidance to publish their scholastic and literary works in publications and manuscript magazines. Regular Academic Enrichment Programmes were conducted with external experts as resource persons.

Mar Thoma College rightly recognizes that the students need platforms to nurture their physical, social and cultural skills, along with their academic competences. The institute provides a range of sports amenities and infrastructure facilities like residential sports coaching facilities. The students are also given ample opportunities to participate in various cultural events and activities at District, State and University levels.
